Christine Martino Talks to ComputerWorld about Future of Linux (Customer Viewable)

Christine Martino, vice president of HP's Open Source & Linux Organization and Linux Foundation board member, recently spoke with Computerworld about what the Linux Foundation is going to focus on. "It's really around three big things -- standardizing and driving the Linux Standard Base (LSB) efforts, promotion and collaboration. I think it's very good to have a neutral party, a nonvendor, promoting Linux. It also sets up a platform for collaboration...whether it's [with] the technical community, developers and even end users," said Martino. More.

Linux Standard Base releases automated testing tools – VNUNet Article (Customer Viewable)

"The Linux Foundation has released an update to its Linux Standard Base (LSB) server specifications to allow for automated testing tools. The update to version 3.1 will make it easier for developers to craft applications that work on multiple Linux distributions. Linux applications currently have to be tested and certified for each Linux distribution. The standard essentially ensures that an LSB 3.1 certified application work(s) across distributions. The LSB initiative however eliminate(s) the need for certification." Read article.

Tekelec, HP to collaborate on open servers for wireless - EE Times (Customer Viewable)

"Tekelec Inc. and Hewlett-Packard Co. announced a joint development and marketing agreement at Wireless 2007 (in Orlando, Fla) in which the partners will combine expertise in blade-based Advanced Telecommunications Computing Architecture (ATCA) servers implementing nodes in IP multimedia subsystems... ATCA servers offered by Tekelec and HP are based on Linux OS and Intel CPUs... Tekelec is free to work on open ATCA solutions with other vendors, but HP is well ahead of other server developers both in telephony applications and in its use of ATCA." More.

HP Japan Scores More Open Source and Linux Wins on BladeSystem (HP Restricted)
